### **AIMS AND SCOPE**

The Journal of Science Teachers and Educators (JOSTE) is a peer-reviewed journal published by the National Organization of Science Teachers and Educators (NOSTE). As an authority in Science Education and Research, it aims to publish for widespread dissemination and utilization of high quality empirical research papers, investigations on innovations and development in the natural sciences and theoretical position papers concerning on-going educational issues in pre-service and in-service education of science teachers. It bridges the gap between research and practice, providing information, ideas and opinion by featuring pragmatic articles that offer ways to improve classroom teaching and learning, professional development, and teacher recruitment and retention across all levels (early childhood, primary, secondary, tertiary, graduate level, workplace and informal learning). Special emphasis is placed on applicable research relevant to educational practice, guided by educational realities.

JOSTE also serves as a platform for neophyte researchers to publish in collaboration with seasoned practitioners, promoting a culture of a nurturing mentoring mechanism that supports novice researchers. In so doing, JOSTE deems to develop future generations of science education and natural science researchers, and at the same time provides an avenue for renowned researchers to fortify the foundation for science education and research in the country.

In order to increase accessibility to non-English-speaking populations while at the same time respect diversity in culture, the journal supports abstracts written in the first language of the principal author.

Submissions that are concerned with natural science (as distinct with science education) are accepted provided a thorough discussion on implications to science education is emphasized in the manuscript.
